i.e. Camp Out, Convention, and Conference

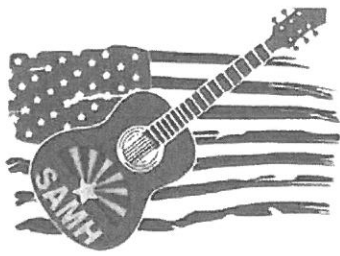

SAMH is a newly approved non-profit 501(c)(3) (#84-2644748) organization founded by Mark Lacy in 2019. Mark a native of Billings, Montana and now a resident of Tucson, Arizona since 2002. Mark is a 20 year U.S. Air Force Law Enforcement veteran who served in Saudi Arabia, Turkey, and Central America and retired in 2006 while assigned 12<sup>th</sup> Air Force, Davis Monthan, Air Force Base. The Organization was created after Mark and his wife, Misty, survived the Las Vegas Harvest Festival Route 91 mass shooting. Mark suffers from and is currently being treated for PTSD brought on by the violent crime he experienced in Las Vegas, Nevada.

SAMH mission is to bring awareness through music events and to raise funds to be distributed to community organizations that provide assistance to those Military, Veterans, First Responders, and Victims of Violent Crimes who are suffering from Mental Health issues (PTSD and Suicidal Ideations).

SAMH is holding their Inaugural Mission 22 Break the Stigma, End Suicide among our Military, Veterans, and First Responders Poker Run/Rally, on 22 Feb 2020. Proceeds from this event will be divided between The Tucson Fisher House (C/O CHAMP Foundation) and Boulder Crest Retreat (Sanoita, Arizona).

We are looking for sponsorship assistance for this event. All organizations/groups/clubs that sponsor \$200 or more will have their organization name recognized on the event t-shirt, our social media platforms, and marketing material. Army Combat Veteran Rowdy Johnson and his Band are scheduled to play country music from 3-8.

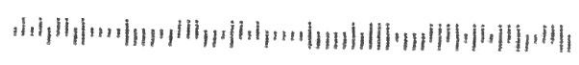
