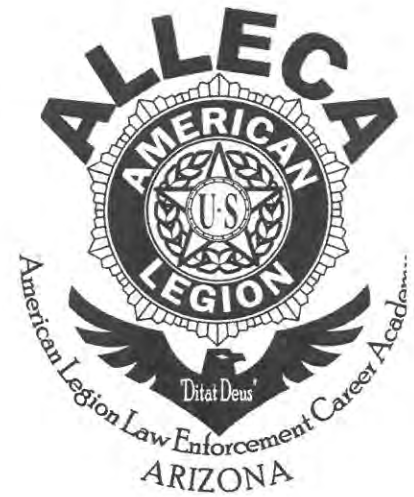



Good Afternoon SAL 39 E-Board,

The attached shows a Food-Saver and related bags that was on sale at Costco. Bill, at my suggestion, went ahead and purchased using cash from our last meal. We had to strike while the items were on sale and available.

A little background is in order...the Post used to have one of these units then it "disappeared" as things have a wont to do in the Post kitchen. This device comes in very handy when buying in bulk, especially when it comes to preserving meat (like steaks) and fresh vegetables (like corn on the cob when it's in season). Normally a steak frozen in a Ziploc bag is good for a month or so. Vacuum sealing the steaks allows for multiple months of freezer storage without degradation.

Purchasing this item goes hand-in hand with the SAL model of buying, using, and preserving our own kitchen items (including a griddle, metal spatulas, vegetable chopper etc.). Purchasing this item will also allow Bill the freedom to take advantage of meat and other sales that he judiciously shops to enhance his track record of "a profit every time we have a kitchen"! Especially on the meat front, with ongoing COVID-19 related periodic shortages, we will be well served to buy in bulk when we can.

I know this is after the fact, but I would request the SAL E-Board provide their aye or nay regarding this expenditure. Depending upon the outcome, I am ready to personally reimburse the SAL if necessary.

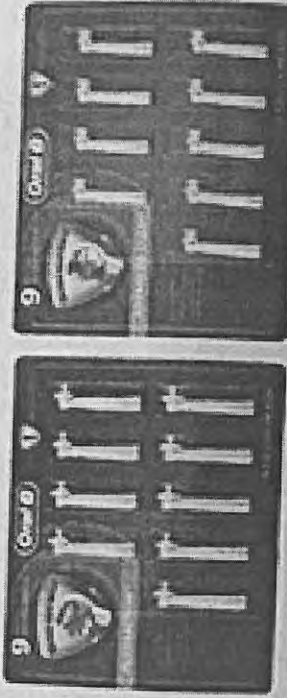

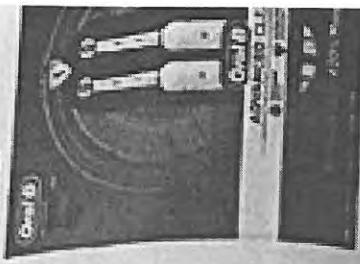

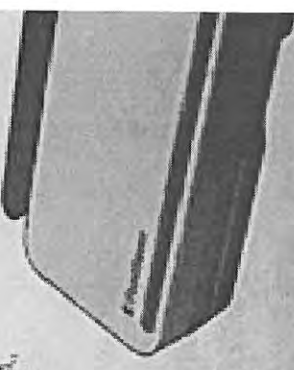
